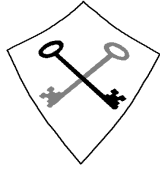
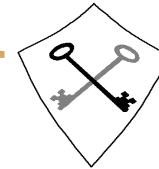


E-Safety at Town Lane Infant School

- We encourage children to keep their passwords safe.

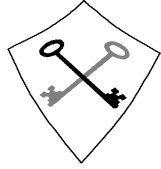


What you can do to keep your child safe online:

- Use parent controls on devices that link to the internet.

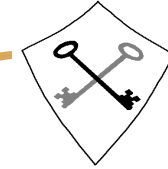

Virtual Learning Environment



What is the VLE?

The virtual learning environment (VLE) is an e-learning education system based on the internet. It gives virtual access to class content, homework, attendance (currently not available), educational links, letters, consent forms, information, opportunities to make payments for trips, dinner money, etc (currently not available).



How to log on:

- Type in the website domain name (www.townlaneinfantschool.eschools.co.uk) into the address bar at the top of your internet browser.
- Click on the login button at the top right hand side of the page.
- Type in your personal username and password to log in.
- You now have access to your child's learning journey.
