Features and Benefits

Safety Mode is an opt-in setting that helps screen out explicit and adult content, to protect your children when they use YouTube. This parental control setting is currently unavailable for the Android and iOS apps. But they do have a safe search filter.




What do I need?

A Google account (Email address and Password)


Step-By-Step

1 Go to youtube.com and click 'Sign in'.







2 Log in to your Google account using your Email address and Password. If you haven't got an account click the 'Create an account' link.



Once you've signed in, scroll down to the bottom of the YouTube page and click on the 'Safety' drop-down menu.




4 Turn Safety Mode on by selecting 'On', followed by 'Save'.



You will need to do this on each browser that you use or if you have multiple Google accounts.



5 The YouTube iOS and Android apps do not have Safety Mode, but do have a SafeSearch filter. To activate press the 'Menu' button in the top left corner of the YouTube app, then press the 'Gear' symbol.



6 In the settings menu select 'SafeSearch filtering' and apply the restriction to suit your family needs.
