Phonics Screening Check We want to say a huge well done to all

children who have taken part in the Phonic Screening Check this week. This is a statutory assessment check for all Year One children that takes place each year in June. Some children in Y2 will also take the test during this week.



We are all so proud of our Year Two children who have coped particularly well with the tests they took part in during the month of May. The teachers are using these tests to inform their judgements about how well they have achieved at the end of Key Stage One. This year, we were moderated externally by the Local Authority and all judgements were verified. Well done to all of our families for your support and to the Year Two team.

UN Convention for the rights of the child

Article 3 (best interests of the child) The best interests on the child must be a top priority in all decisions and actions that affect children

Article 12 (respect for the views of the child) Every child has the right to express their views, feelings and wishes in all matters affecting them, and to have their views considered and taken seriously. This right applies at all times

Article 28 (right to education) Every child has the right to an education.

Article 29 (goals of education) Education must develop every child's personality, talents and abilities to the full. It must encourage the child's respect for human rights, as well as respect for their parents, their own and other cultures, and the environment

Article 31 (leisure, play and culture) Every child has the right to relax, play and take part in a wide range of cultural and artistic activities.
